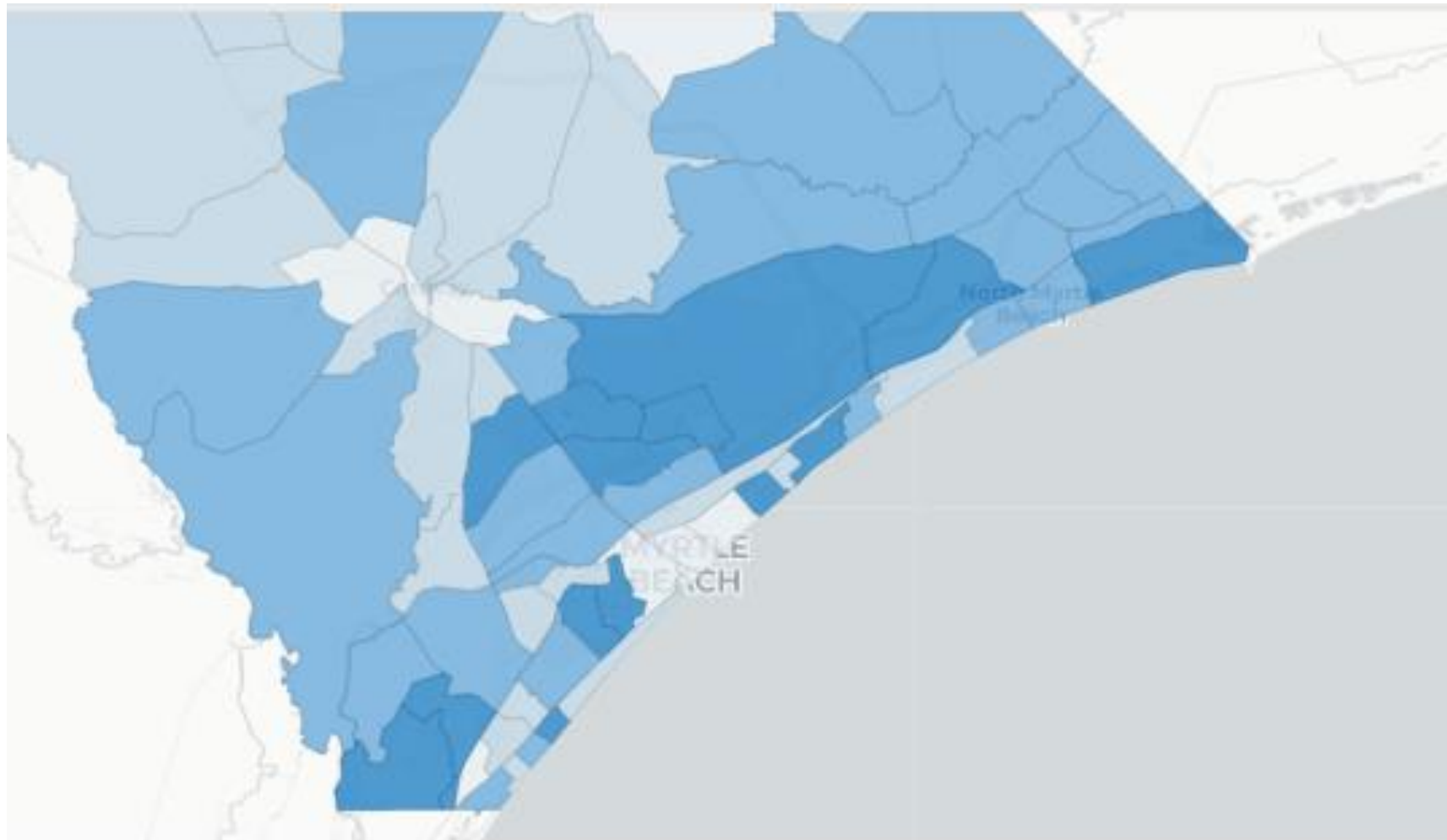

Health

85.3% of the population of Horry County, SC has health coverage

- 32.4% on employee plans
- 17.3% on Medicaid
- 18% on Medicare
- 14.6% on non-group plans
- 2.95% on military or VA plans

Per capita personal health care spending in the county of Horry County, SC was \$7,311 in 2014. This is a 4.15% increase from the previous year (\$7,020).

Primary care physicians in Horry County, SC see 1602 patients per year on average, which represents a 4.01% decrease from the previous year (1669 patients). Compare this to dentists who see 2621 patients per year, and mental health providers who see 738 patients per year.

Comparing across all counties in the state, Dillon County has the highest prevalence of diabetes (20.1%).

Additionally, Lee County has the highest prevalence of adult obesity (42.8%)

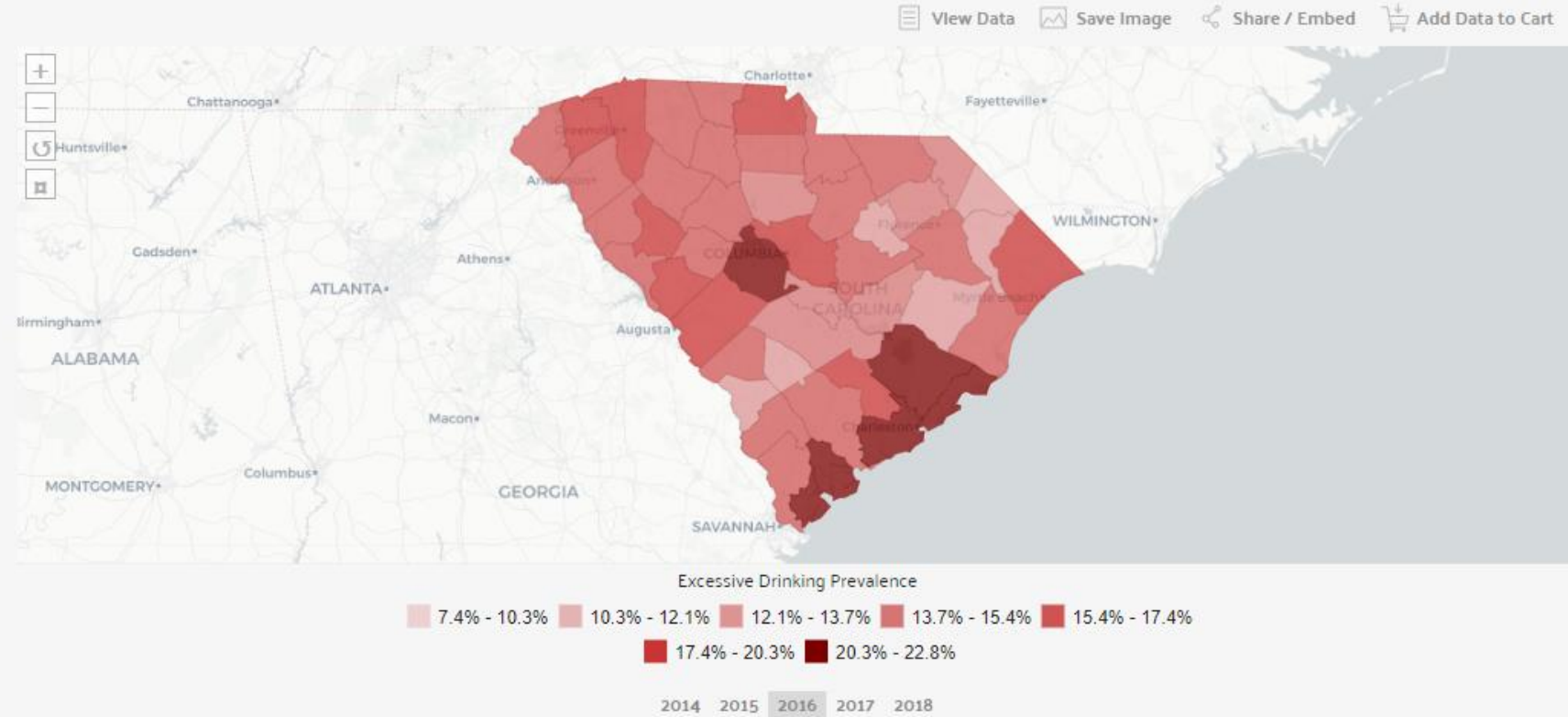
Excessive Drinking
